CIRCULAR TO STUDENTS

Based on the directions from the Department of Higher Education, Government of Tamil Nadu, it has been decided to reopen college post lockdown due to Covid-19 pandemic for the Second and Final Year Undergraduate and Postgraduate students of the college. The classes will be conducted on rotation basis with effect from 01.09.2021.

The students are directed to strictly comply with the following rules with respect to the Standard Operation Procedure:

- Students should strictly follow the guidelines issued by the authorities from time to time.
- Students living in areas declared as containment zones will not be allowed to attend college and are also advised to kindly refrain from visiting any areas falling within containment zones.
- Symptomatic students will not be permitted inside the college. They will be allowed only after getting clinically assessed about being fit.
- Any student who has come in direct contact with an infected or a symptomatic person should isolate themselves in order to stop further spread.
- Students are advised to get vaccinated before attending college.
- Maintain self-discipline to avoid the spread of the pandemic.
- It is important to maintain personal hygiene: Wash your hands frequently; Cover face with tissue or elbow while coughing or sneezing; Avoid touching face, nose, mouth, eyes and ears.
- It is compulsory for the students to cooperate with the Security Staff and undergo thermal scanning while entering the college.
- Students have to maintain social distance at all times.
- Students should compulsorily wear face masks inside the college at all times.
- Students are instructed to practice frequent sanitization of hands.
- Wearing of gloves is recommended for the safety of the students.
- It is mandatory for the students to wear ID cards while being in the college campus.
- Spitting in the campus is a punishable offence.
- Students should follow hygiene practices while using common facilities and utilities.
- Students should practice regular sanitization of laptops and other gadgets.
- Used face masks, gloves, tissue papers and any other personal protective equipment should be disposed only in the dustbins designated for the purpose.
- It is important for the students to inform the Head of the Department about any illness of self or family members.
- Students have to submit a self-declaration if in case any of their family members are infected with or getting treated for Covid -19.
- Students are advised to stay physically and mentally fit and are encouraged to practice meditation, yoga, breathing exercise etc.
- Inculcate immunity-boosting habits like healthy eating, doing exercise and sleeping on time.

- Do not discriminate fellow students with a history of Covid infection.
- Avoid sharing of books, learning materials, gadgets or eatables.
