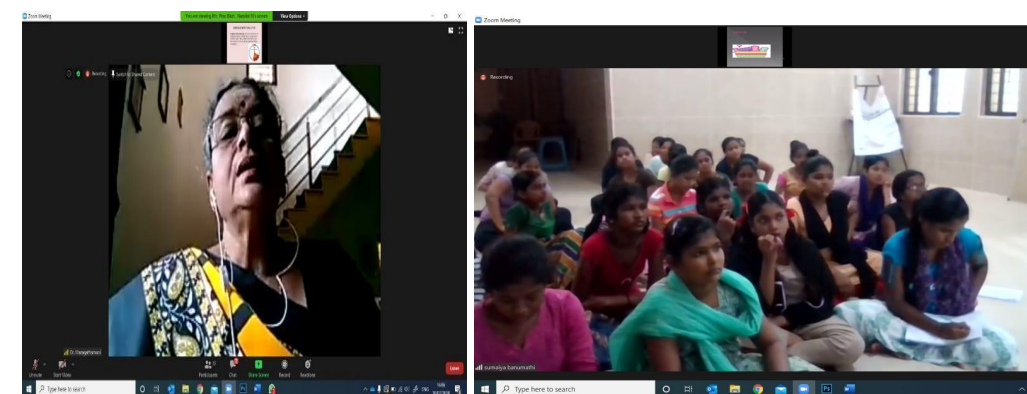
INSTALLATION CEREMONY- SAHASRA

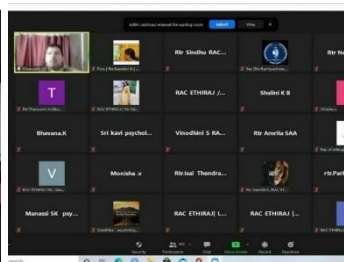




YATRA

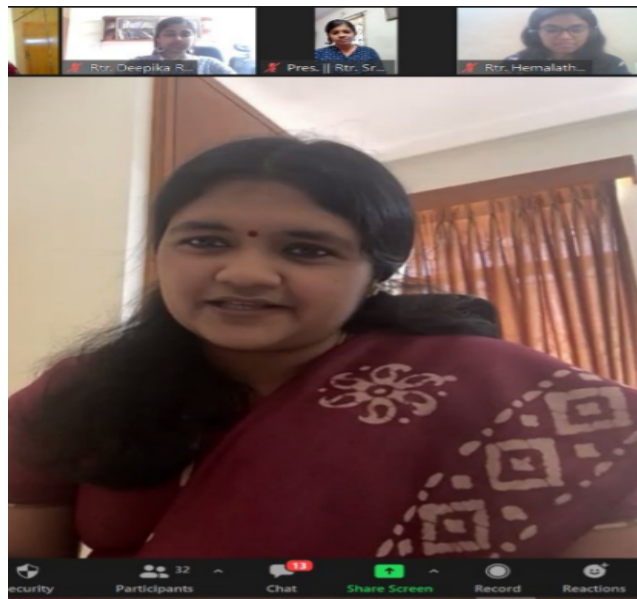
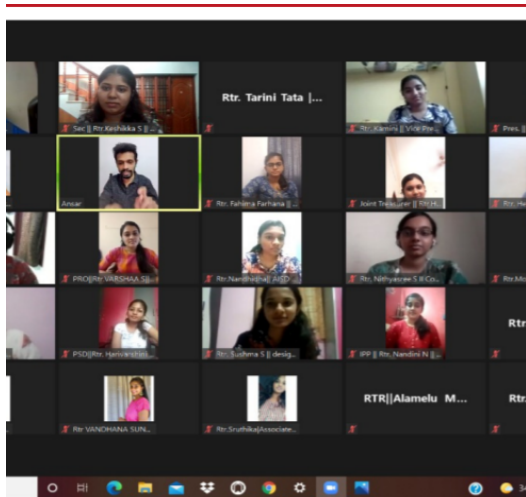
IMPART-UPSKILL TO REVAMP THE HEIRLOOM

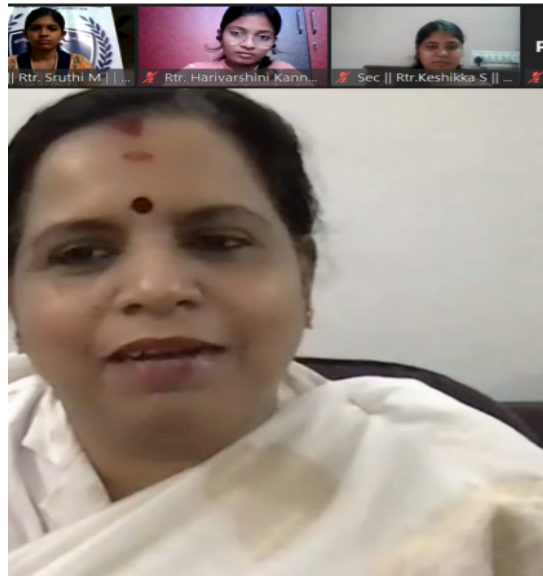
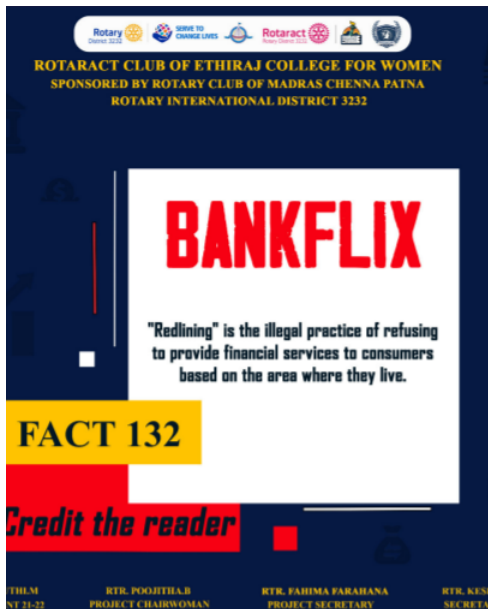
BANKFLIX – CREDIT THE READER

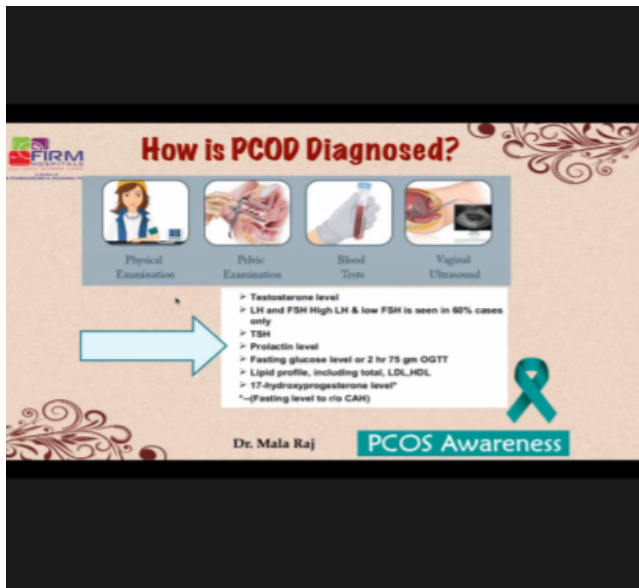
YUVATHI-WINDOW TO WOMEN'S HEALTH

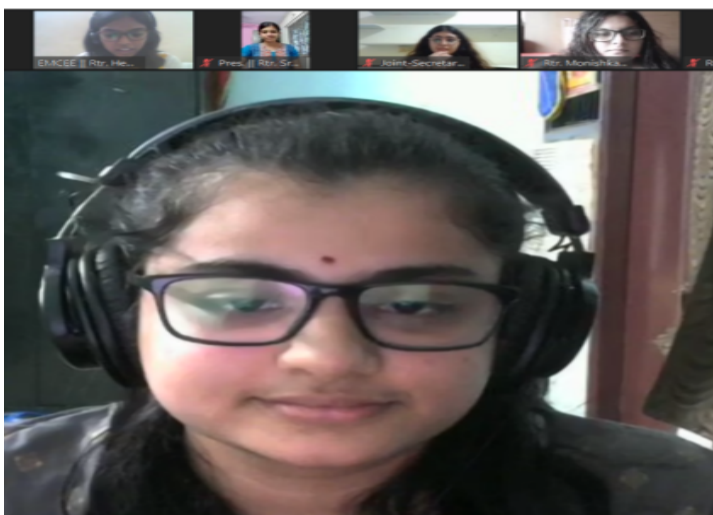
PAARAMBARYAM – DIVE INTO TRADITION

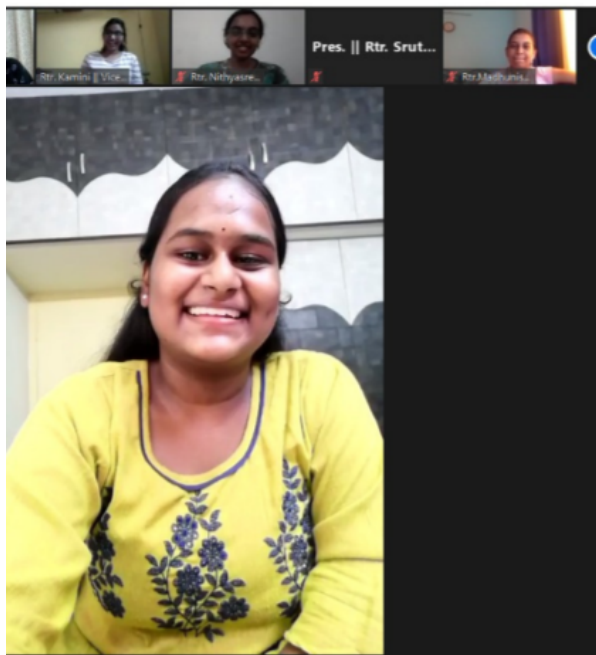
CENTRAL PERK-THE PLACE WHERE F.R.I.E.N.D.S MEET

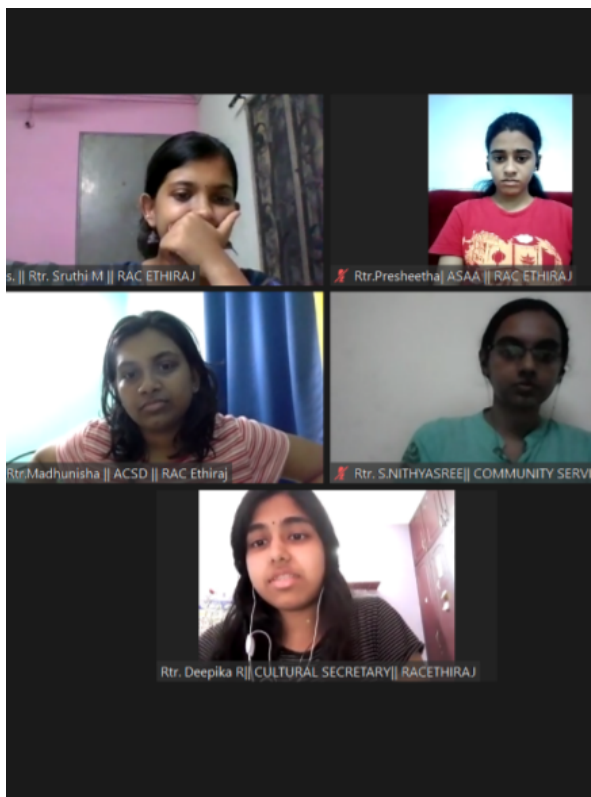
AMITY-ETCHING FRESH MEMORIES
