

# **Department Activities:**

## **2015-16**

- The literary events of the Postgraduate and Research Department of English for the year 2015-16 commenced with the Oratorical and Essay Competition on 11<sup>th</sup> July 2015 to commemorate the Founder's Day. *N. ## 2017-18

- On 1<sup>st</sup> of September 2018, Sadanand Menon, writer and art critic, formally inaugurated **Athena 17**, the department’s annual literary festival.
- In the first week of December, the department hosted “Poetry with Prakriti”, a poetry festival organized by Prakriti Foundation. Padma Shri Allan Sealy and eight other prominent poets read out their poems and interacted with the students.

## 2018-19

- The academic year 2018-19 got off to a flying start with the Oratorical competition on 6<sup>th</sup> July 2019 to commemorate the birth anniversary of our revered founder Sri V.L.Ethiraj. Students from various colleges had participated enthusiastically in the several events that the Association had offered. Stella Maris College had won the overall trophy.
