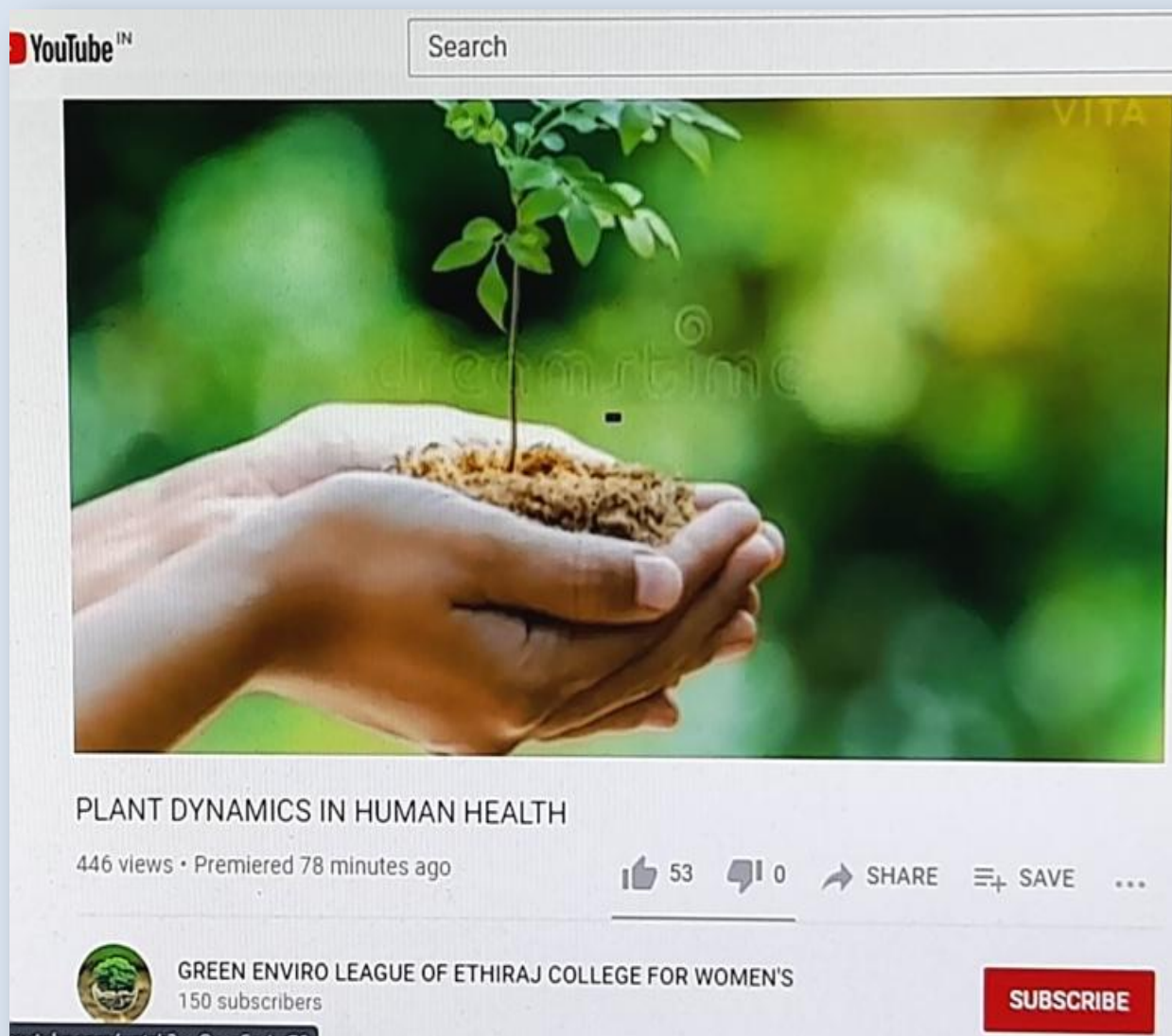

PLANT DYNAMICS IN HUMAN HEALTH

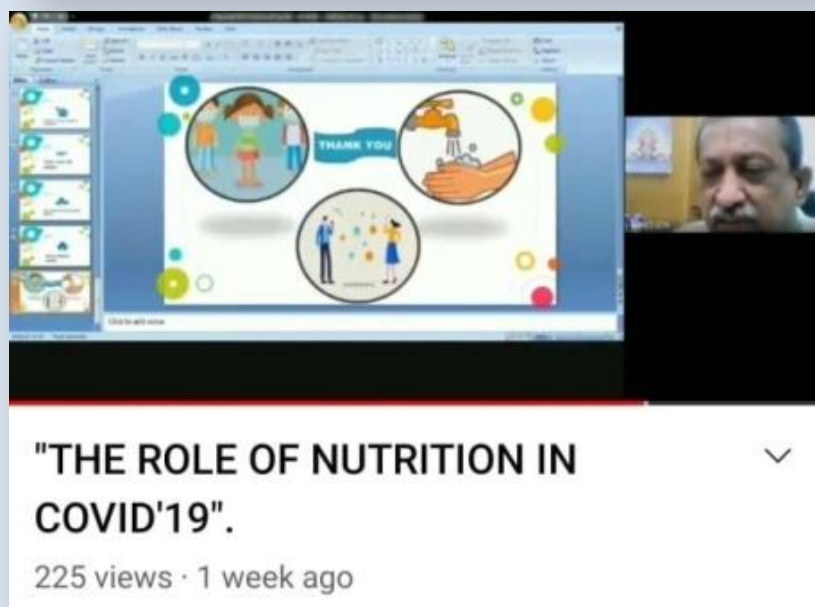
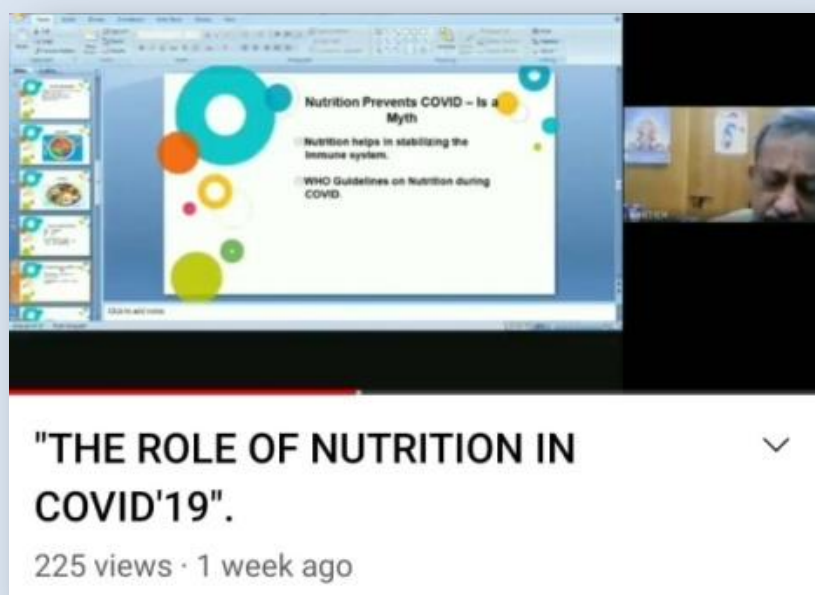
