Moving along with the rapid growth of the Information Technology, Ethiraj College for Women imparts training and education in the field of Computer Applications at the Post Graduate Level, "Master of Computer Applications". The programme was started in the academic year (1999-2000). As per AICTE guidelines from the academic year 2021-2022, MCA programme, will be offered as a 2 year full time programme. The department kindles the students to cope-up with various current trends and technological updates. It conducts orientation programmes and workshops to improve both the technical and soft skills of the students. The department motivates and cultivates the will power and brings out the technical skills in students and continues its successful journey in delivering talented perspective young women MCA graduates to the information and communication era.

The MCA course is affiliated to University of Madras and approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) Approval No: F. No: TN-58/MCP-CS/98 dated September 23, 1998 and the course got its Autonomy status in the year 2006.



Course Structure

The new curriculum is focusing on learning aspects from three dimensions of Conceptual Learning, Skills Learning and Practical/Hands on experience. The programme offers core papers, electives, extra disciplinary papers, soft-skill papers, internship, practical papers and major project.

In today's world where cut-throat competition is prevailing in the market, theoretical knowledge is not sufficient. The main objective of project training at MCA level is to develop skills in student and supplement the theoretical study of Computer Applications in depth. It provides student with a fundamental knowledge of recent trends in Information Technology and activities as well as an exposure to strategic thinking of doing real-time applications.

Duration of the Course

The course duration shall be **two years** consisting of **four semesters**. In order to be eligible for the award of the degree, the candidate shall successfully complete the course in the maximum period of five years reckoned from the date of enrolment for the first semester of the course.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Eligibility Criterion

Candidates, who have passed the under-mentioned degree examinations under 10 + 2 + 3 or 11+1+3 or 11+2+2 pattern or under the Open University System, shall be eligible for admission to the M.C.A Degree Course.

Library

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The college houses a eclectic collection of academic texts, reference books, national and international journals, magazines and newspapers. The library has a conference hall, reading rooms, photocopying facility and Internet Browsing Centre. It also provides access to research database EBSCO and 'Inflibnet' that help the students in their study and research activities. The Department has an exclusive library with more than 10,000 books, national and Inernational journals, e-journals etc.

Hostel

The college hostel provides housing for 540 students across three separate buildings. At the time of admission, students will also be required to submit a separate application to stay in the college's dorms. The rule known as "First-come, First-served" pertains to how admission to the hostel works.

Placement Activities

The activities of the placement cell, aims to match the requirements of the recruiters with the aspiring students. The campus recruitment conducted yearly, has witnessed more and more blue chip companies seeking to recruit students belonging to different specializations.
