#### **Interdepartmental Events**



The workshop concluded with discussions, Q& A sessions and feedback. Through the powerful medium of theatre, they advocated improved mental health support.

Eligibility for scholarships is determined by academic performance of the students. Depending on the grades, the overseas organization will allocate the appropriate countries and universities for the students. This helped the students attain knowledge on applying for higher studies abroad.
